

## **Legal Notice and General Terms of Use of the Website**

These Legal Notices and General Terms of Use (hereinafter, the “Legal Notice”) govern access to and use of the website (hereinafter, the “Website”), owned by Giuliano Tartufi S.p.A. (hereinafter, the “Company”). Accessing and browsing the Site implies full acceptance of these Legal Notices by the user or visitor (hereinafter, the “User”).

### **Art. 1 - Purpose and Legal Nature of the Website**

This Website is intended solely for informational, presentational, and promotional purposes (“showcase website”) and is designed to present the catalog of Giuliano Tartufi brand products.

Under no circumstances does the Website constitute a direct sales channel (e-commerce), nor may the information and images contained therein be interpreted as an offer to the public pursuant to Art. 1336 of the Civil Code. Consequently, the contents of the Website do not constitute a binding contractual offer or an invitation to purchase within the meaning of Legislative Decree 206/2005 (Consumer Code).

### **Art. 2 - Intellectual and Industrial Property**

All content present on or made available through the Website—including, but not limited to, registered and unregistered trademarks (e.g., “Spolverata di Tartufo®”), logos, text, recipes, product descriptions, photographs, and the graphic design and layout of the pages—is the exclusive property of the Company or its legitimate licensors.

Such content is protected by applicable national and international laws governing industrial and intellectual property, with particular reference to Legislative Decree No. 30 of February 10, 2005 (Industrial Property Code). The reproduction, modification, copying, distribution, systematic extraction of data (so-called “data scraping”), or any other form of exploitation for commercial purposes of the Website’s content is strictly prohibited without the Company’s prior written authorization.

### **Art. 3 - Fair Information Practices and the Preeminent Role of Physical Labeling**

In accordance with the principles of maximum transparency and consumer protection, it is hereby declared that the only legally valid, binding, and up-to-date source of information regarding the characteristics of food products is the physical labeling affixed to each package.

This includes, without limitation: the list of ingredients, the presence of allergens, the nutrition facts panel, storage instructions, the minimum storage period or expiration date, and any other mandatory information pursuant to Regulation (EU) No. 1169/2011. Although the Company takes the utmost care in updating the Website’s content, the information provided here is for informational purposes only and in no way replaces the information on the label of the delivered product.

#### **Art. 4 - Intended Use and Target Audience**

The content of the Website and product information are intended primarily for institutional customers and professional operators in the Ho.Re.Ca. sector. The Website does not sell directly to end consumers, who are invited to contact authorized retailers.

#### **Art. 5 - Authenticity of Species and Accuracy of Designations**

In compliance with Law No. 752 of December 16, 1985, the Company guarantees the authenticity of the truffle species used, which are identified on the label according to the official scientific nomenclature. The exact species and the corresponding percentage of truffle are indicated in a binding manner exclusively on the mandatory labeling of each product.

#### **Art. 6 - Information on Allergens and Relevant Substances**

The complete and specific list of allergens for each product is provided exclusively on the product's label. In general, products may contain or have traces of allergens (e.g., celery, sulfites, milk and dairy products, gluten, etc.). Users are advised to always review the specific labeling on the packaging carefully before consumption or use.

#### **Art. 7 - Storage Instructions and Recommended Dosages**

Specific storage instructions before and after opening the package are strictly indicated on the label of each product. The quantity guidelines and suggested serving sizes provided in the product descriptions (e.g., "one teaspoon per person," "5–7 g per serving") are purely for guidance and are not binding, as they may vary depending on the specific recipe and personal taste.

#### **Art. 8 - Content Updates and Product Changes**

The Company reserves the right to modify product formulations, commercial formats, and packaging at any time without prior notice. The information on the Website is subject to periodic review. The User must rely exclusively on the physical labeling of the purchased product, which reflects its most up-to-date and legally compliant status.

#### **Art. 9 - Technical Documentation and Sales Contacts**

Professionals interested in receiving detailed technical data sheets, certifications, HACCP documentation, dedicated price lists, or in discussing contractual terms of supply are invited to contact the Company's sales department directly through the appropriate channels listed in the "Contact Us" section.
