1. Purpose and Legal Nature of the Website

5. Truffle Species and Botanical Designations

Products in the Truffle Pure line use the following truffle species, identified on the label according to official scientific nomenclature:

- ***Tuber aestivum Vitt.*** (Summer Truffle or Scorzone)
- ***Tuber magnatum Pico*** (White Truffle)
- ***Tuber melanosporum Vitt.*** (Black Truffle)
- ***Tuber borchii Vitt.*** (Bianchetto Truffle)

Botanical identification guarantees the authenticity of the species used in accordance with Italian Law No. 752 of December 16, 1985. The exact species and truffle percentage relative to the finished product are stated in a binding manner in the mandatory labeling of each individual product.

6. Allergens

The complete and specific list of allergens for each product is stated exclusively on its label. Please carefully read the specific labeling on the packaging before use or consumption.

In general, products in the Truffle Pure line may contain or show traces of the following allergens:

- **Celery** – possible traces.
- **Sulfites** – possible traces, particularly in brine-preserved products.

Additionally, products may be manufactured in facilities that handle other allergens, including: **cereals containing gluten, milk and dairy products (including lactose), eggs, soy, mustard, mollusks, fish, and tree nuts.** For a complete list, please refer to the label or contact the company directly.

Brine, Net Weight, and Drained Weight

Whole truffles preserved in brine contain a packing liquid (composed of water, salt, and possibly flavorings) that may be used as an aromatic element and base for culinary preparations.

For all products preserved in a packing liquid (brine or oil), the label clearly states both the net weight and the drained weight, in compliance with applicable regulations.

7. Storage Instructions

Products in the Truffle Pure line are prepared and sold using the following preservation methods:

- **In brine** (for whole truffles)
- **In oil** (for sliced truffles)
- **Dried** (for dried truffle)
- **Concentrated** (for creams and ground preparations)

Specific storage instructions before and after opening, recommended storage temperatures, and use-by dates after opening are stated for each product exclusively on its label.

8. Recommended Serving Sizes

Quantity guidelines and suggested serving sizes provided in individual product descriptions (e.g., “one teaspoon per person,” “5–7 g per serving,” “2 g per serving”) are purely indicative and non-binding.
